

As part of the International Assessment and Review process under the Convention, developed countries prepare reports every two years. These reports highlight the findings on the progress made by developed countries in meeting their 2020 targets, including the innovative climate actions and institutional frameworks that are constructing a launch pad for success under the Paris Agreement in the period after 2020. The reports also highlight the financial, technology and capacity-building support provided to developing country Parties.
