**Actions and support before 2020: Where are we?
Paving the way for success under the Paris**

As part of the International Assessment and Review process under the Convention, developed countries prepare reports every two years. These reports highlight the findings on the progress made by developed countries in meeting their 2020 targets, including the innovative climate actions and institutional frameworks that are constructing a launch pad for success under the Paris Agreement in the period after 2020. The reports also highlight the financial, technology and capacity-building support provided to developing country Parties. Following the mandate of COP 17 the UNFCCC secretariat has prepared a summary report of these reports submitted by developed countries by 2018. This summary report is available [here](#).
