Objective:

To support LDCs voice out the need to improve operational rules of CDM at UNFCCC COP15 and its beyond, in order to facilitate and increase CDM activities in LDCs - JICA endeavors to promote CDM in LDC for bridging CDM and poverty reduction

CDM Effective for "Human Security" in LDCs

- LDC endowed with potential of CDM contributing to poverty reduction (i.e. clean energy) -CER sales revenue to improve living standard of the poor → Contributing to

realization of

"human security"

Slow Progress of CDM Activities in LDC

- In LDC, technical difficulties impede smooth formulation of CDM activities
- Rigorous CDM rules require much more than just training
- → Countries with "Fewer than 10" CDM activities need "special rule"

Delivering JICA Experience to Int'l Discussion

- -JICA helping Zambia and Bhutan shape CDM (both rural electrification projects financed by JICA)
- Such experience enables identifying bottlenecks for discussion at CDM EB and needs of LDCs, leading to concrete proposals for reform at int'l discussion

Supporting CDM in LDC thru Japan's ODA

- Planning and realizing underlying finance and other assistance to CDM projects that enable to reduce poverty in LDCs
- Promoting "low carbon development" thru clean energies which alleviate poverty and stimulate economic growth

Discussion with Core LDCs

- Together with LDCs receiving JICA assistance (such as Zambia, Bhutan and Uganda), discuss concrete ideas for CDM reform by sharing common understanding about the high potential of CDM in realizing "human security"

Presentation at Bangkok AWG

- With LDCs in favor of reform, present ideas for CDM reform at a side event held at Bangkok Ad-hoc Working Group (Oct) - To propose LDCs group to collectively request implementation of such proposal at COP15

Consensus among LDCs

- -LDCs in favor of reform proposal to discuss with other LDCs to propose such reform under one voice of "LDCs"
- → If successful,
 LDCs group to
 demand reform at
 COP15 as consensus
 and aim to include
 the demand in COP
 decision
