


Provision of timely BTR support a priority for GEF

49 BTRs in 48 countries supported since 2021

- \$35.2 million to support BTRs
- BTR1 (48), BTR2 (1)
- Stand-alone BTR1 (20), Combined BTR1/NC (27), Other (1)
- Umbrella Program option
- Brazil, India. Malaysia, Mexico, and Nigeria used STAR

Report: National Communication (NC)




History of support and inclusion in ETF

521 NCs supported since 1995

As of October 31, 2022:

- 152 countries
- \$299 million total
- Top up with STAR resources in some countries
- Transition to ETF












Capacity: Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency



Growing, balanced portfolio

- 88 projects in 86 countries totaling \$145 million
- +84% of portfolio under implementation
- Geographically balanced: 32 projects in Africa, 22 in LAC, 20 in Asia, 9 in ECA
- 56% of non-Annex I Parties supported and
 77% of total non-Annex I GHG emissions covered
- 5 global projects to enhance knowledge exchange, sector capacity
- 7 Agencies: CI, FAO, FECO, IDB, UNEP, UNDP, and WWF-US

Global Support Program (GSP)

- Concluded in September 2021
- Reviews, technical support and backstopping of NCs and BURs
- Training, best practices on GHG inventories, IPCC guidelines
- Gender mainstreaming, vulnerability & adaptation assessments, mitigation actions
- South-South communities of practice
- Supported over 140 countries

CBIT GSP

Unified Support Platform and Program for Article 13

- Provide streamlined support and capacity building at country, regional, and global level
- Enable countries better respond to reporting requirements
- Catalyze increased ambition within NDCs
- Phase IIA + IIB as a package, with UNEP
- IIA and IIB cleared for implementation in July and December 2021









Outlook: GEF-8 Support



GEF-8 (July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2026)





- ☐ CBIT: Increased to \$75 million (\$55 million in GEF-7)
- □ BTR support increase: \$600,000 for stand-alone, \$633,000 for BTR+NC \$250,000 for top-up
- ☐ Support for multiple reports possible

ETF support

- ☐ Growing demand for CBIT and BTR towards 2024 deadline
- ☐ Anticipate requests for second CBIT "phase" support
- ☐ Explore interlinkages and align BTR and CBIT projects
- ☐ Engage with COP Presidency, UNFCCC, countries, and partners
