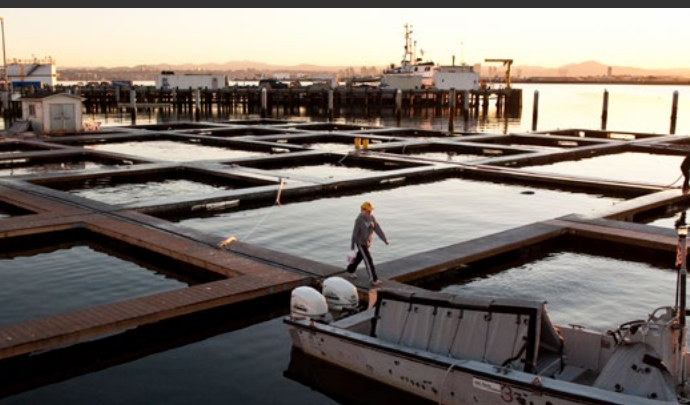
Water Diplomacy
