What are SD-PAMs?

- No official definition
- Suggestion (Winkler et al 2002):
 - Domestically driven
 - Diverse approaches
 - Development focus
- Potentially wide-ranging policy types/areas ...
- ... with direct or indirect GHG effects
- Which policies "qualify" as SD-PAMS?
- Can countries pick and choose?



Who would participate?

- Need for a policy decision
- Significant changes since Rio/Kyoto …
 - Importance of non-Annex I emissions (yearly and cumulative)
 - High growth (TPES, GDP) in some NAI
 - Country groupings (OECD, EU)
- Key indicators in some NAI countries exceed 1990 Annex I average





How could SD-PAMs fit in climate regime (1)?

- 1. SD-PAMs generate credits
- SD-PAMs generate "SD-PAM" GHG credits
 - How to quantify emission reductions?
 - Credit all ERs from "win win" policies?
 - Impact on willingness to take country targets?
- SD-PAMs generate credits via CDM (e.g. programme of activities)



How could SD-PAMs fit in climate regime (2)?


- 2. SD-PAMs encouraged by other means, e.g.
 - Integrated component of post-2012 climate regime
 - External (co-)financing
- 3. SD-PAMs generate recognition only
 - Formal recognition for GHG mitigation
- To credit (or not) a major question, with significant implementation questions



Process for implementation

- Need to agree processes for SD-PAM:
 - Identification
 - Submission
 - Preparation
 - Financing
 - Approval/registration
 - Monitoring/reporting
 - Review/evaluate
- How much can be done under UNFCCC framework?





Conclusions

- Much interest (but lack of clarity) on SD-**PAMs**
- If SD-PAMs are part of post-2012 regime, need to agree:
 - Purpose, definition, eligibility
 - Process for implementation
- More or less stringent international oversight needed, depending on SD-PAM aim
