Accelerating implementation of climate action on agriculture

With the adoption of the decision 3/CP.27 'Sharm el-Sheikh joint work on implementation of climate action on agriculture and food security', Parties gave a strong signal: agriculture and food security must remain as negotiation stream under the UNFCCC. The last six years have been crucial for building a common understanding around the responses of climate change impacts in agriculture, and yet the challenge to translate this into concrete action on the ground supporting implementation of the Paris Agreement remains.

The negotiations and mandated work on agriculture and food security under UNFCCC are providing countries with insights into opportunities for more ambitious climate targets in the agricultural sector while ensuring food security to be integrated in the next series of NDC updates in 2025.

This session aims to facilitate a constructive dialogue between representatives from negotiator groups and country representatives from all regions on opportunities that the discussions on agriculture under UNFCCC offer to improve national policies and commitments (NDCs, NAPs and LT-LEDS).
