## 1. Problem

- More than 80% of 22 M Mozambican depends exclusively on biomass for cooking and other activities.
- This situation will remain the same for many years affecting negatively local and global environment, including degradation of health condition for the users.



### 2. How? LEDC : Local Apropriation and decentralization

- Communities participate on the LED: mobilization, planning, access to information and implementation of energy sustainable solutions
- Produce improved stoves repairing of photo-voltaic systems, running saving and micro credit groups and other topics.



# 3. Impact

- Created alternative income for more than 50 people involved in the production and has a great impact on users(saving of up to 40 % energy.)
- 28.000 stoves of different categories have been produced and sold.
- Established business company to build and sell institutional stoves



# 4.challenges

- Covering the whole value chain of biomass energy
- Expanding the production of improved stoves to the whole country through capacity building of local organizations
- Introducing concept of carbon credits to finance the sustainability of the stove program
