

### Experiences with the current MRV framework: success stories

#### **Gradually improving**

- A comprehensive national GHG inventory, time series available for 1990-2013
- A web-tool for GHG inventories analysis
- A regional GHG inventories network
- Three National Communications
- Two BURs, 2014 and 2016

# **Experiences with the current MRV framework: challenges**

### The usual suspects?

- Capacities and domestic coordination
- BUR guidelines: not specific enough?
- ICA: Feedback for improved reporting

# Enhancement of existing capacities and structures in national MRV systems

### A cross-government effort: informal, but effective!

- Process led by the Ministry for Environment
- Bottom-up approach
- CC focal points
- Clear schedule / outcomes

# Benefits of a robust national reporting system:

#### More and better information

- Evidence for policy making
- Effective buy-in from stakeholders
- Improved national statistics
  - Data at sub-national level
  - More transparency

### Way forward and challenges for the ETF

### Still a lot to do, but possible and worthwile

- Forward looking capacities
  - Modelling scenarios
  - Emission trends and trajectories
  - Impact assessment of climate action
- Strengthen institutional capacities
  - Sustainability
  - Communication efforts
