



## SUPPORT PROGRAMME TO RESPOND TO CLIMATE CHANGE (SP-RCC)

- Established in 2009 by JICA, AfD and the Government of Viet Nam
- Main development partners: JICA, AfD, WB, CIDA, K-exim Bank, DFAT
- Main ministries: MONRE, MPI, MOF, MARD, MOT, MOIT, MOST, MOC, MOH, MOET
- Serves as the most important policy dialogue platform on climate change in Viet Nam

  - AFD: 110 millions Euro

SP - RCC

1.Proactively responding to natural disasters and climate monitoring

- 2. Securing water and food security
- 3. Effectively responding to sealevel rise and natural disasters
- 4. Protecting forests and conservation of bio-diversity

5. Mitigating the GHG emissions

6. Reinforcing the role of the government in responding to climate change

7. Establishing communities to respond to climate change

8. Diversifying the financial resources and improving investment effectiveness
