The event updates on progress of Pathways to Dairy Net Zero, a global initiative launched in 2021 to accelerate the dairy sector's climate action while continuing to provide nutrition for six billion people and livelihoods for one billion. Since its launch last year during the UN Food Systems Summit, the climate initiative has gained the support of more than 120 leading organizations and governments, including the 10 largest dairy companies in the world. Collectively, these supporters represent nearly 40% of global milk production.

Pathways to Dairy Net Zero is an initiative unlike any other in agriculture in terms of size and scope. It brings together dairy farms of every size and type, as well as organizations throughout the dairy supply chain. This side event will present new research findings on global mitigation approaches and report progress in both developed and emerging markets.
