

Ambitious Climate Policies

- Avoid temperature increase above 2 degrees Celsius.
- A broad, ambitious, and fair agreement.
- Committed to over-fulfill our obligations under the Kyoto protocol
- Carbon neutrality by 2050.
- Develop climate friendly technologies, such as CCS.
- Financial contribution towards preventing deforestation in developing countries in the orden of NOK 3 billion per year
