

Issues and Solutions for CDM Reform in fewer than 10 CDM projects

- Uncertainties over CDM process
- Interpretation creates uncertainties
- More default values should be introduced

Disparities CDM rule & actual situations

- New guideline for Additionality was welcomed
- Standardized baseline needs to be elaborated
- DNAs play an important role in this regard
