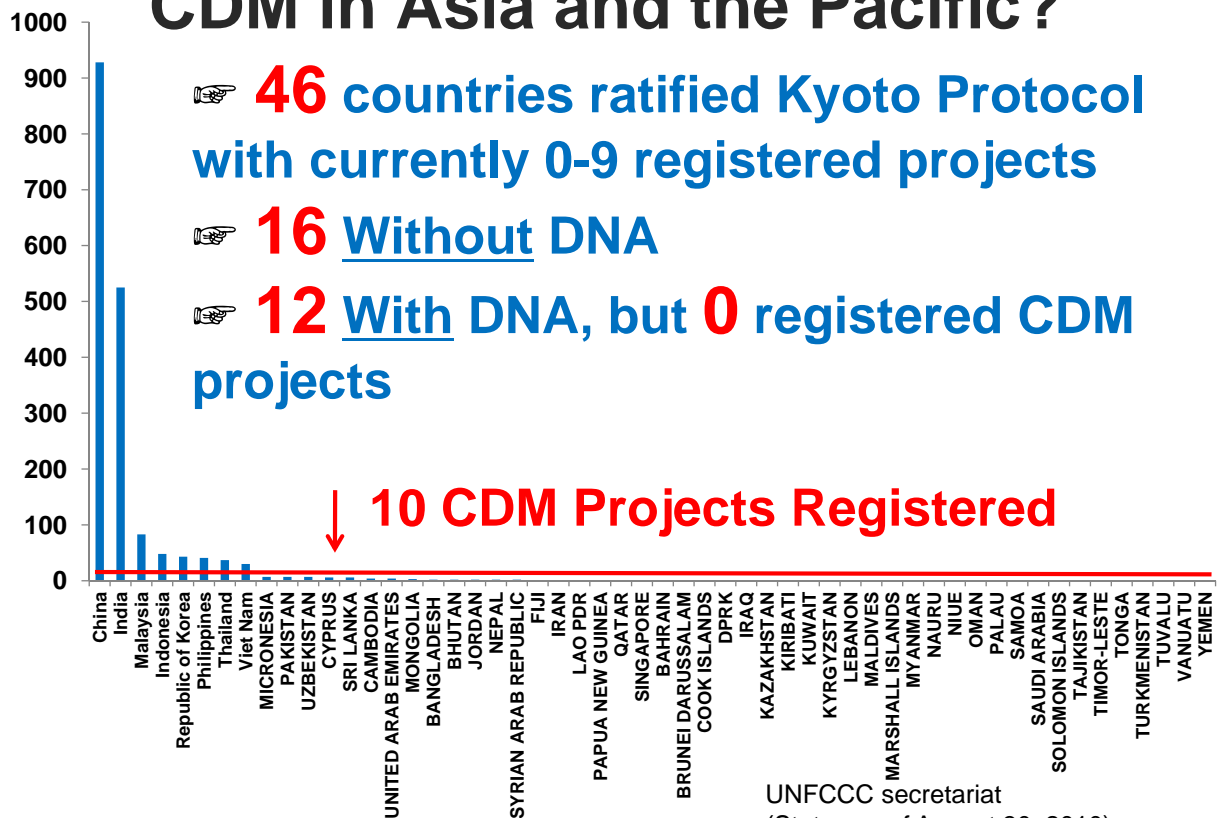

Issues and Solutions for CDM Reform in fewer than 10 CDM projects

◆ ***Uncertainties over CDM process***

- ☞ *Interpretation creates uncertainties*
- ☞ *More default values should be introduced*

◆ ***Disparities CDM rule & actual situations***

- ☞ *New guideline for Additionality was welcomed*
- ☞ *Standardized baseline needs to be elaborated*
- ☞ *DNAs play an important role in this regard*

◆ ***Lack of continued financial support***

- ☞ *CDM can be a driving force, but the project development requires continued support.*
