# Aim

- Better and coherent implementation of regional and global environmental agreements
- Cross-sectoral understanding and cooperation on this implementation, emphasising the relevance of environment to other sectors, and vice versa

# Objective

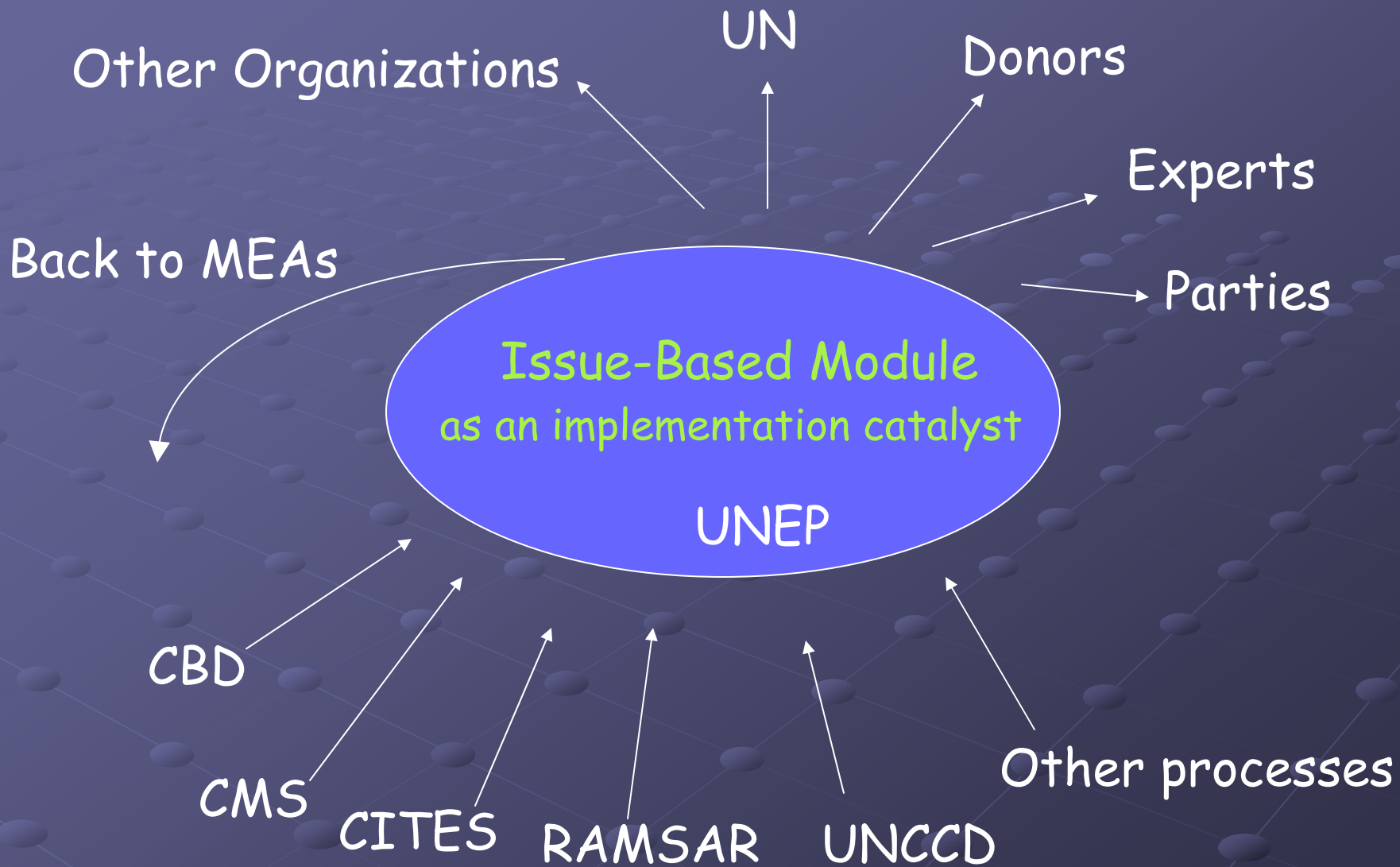
- **Improve understanding** of how commitments taken under different MEAs relate one to another and to other relevant agreements on issues of common concern.
- **Demonstrate** how implementation of each individual MEA and other relevant agreements can be strengthened through more integrated action on issues of common concern.
- **Promote cooperation** between experts at the national level working on implementation of different MEAs and other relevant agreements on issues of common concern.

# Characteristics of the Module

- Issue Based: Inland Water, Invasive Alien Species, Sustainable Use, Climate Change
- Analysis of existing decisions of different agreements, separated according to implementation agents
- Practical, voluntary and evolutionary tool,
- Combining global and regional agreements
- Identifying the relationship between decisions of different MEAs to demonstrate overlaps, potential conflicts and possible gaps
- Web based and on CD-Rom

# Project Planning

- **Phase I:** development of 4 global modules based on the global agreements (CBD, UNFCCC, UNCCD, CMS, CITES, Ramsar, WHC, + others)
- **Phase II:** adaptation of the global modules with regional requirements
- **Phase III:** introduction of the modules through regional meetings and start of implementation in Pilot Countries

  - More background documents
  - Feedback and Search functions to be developed
