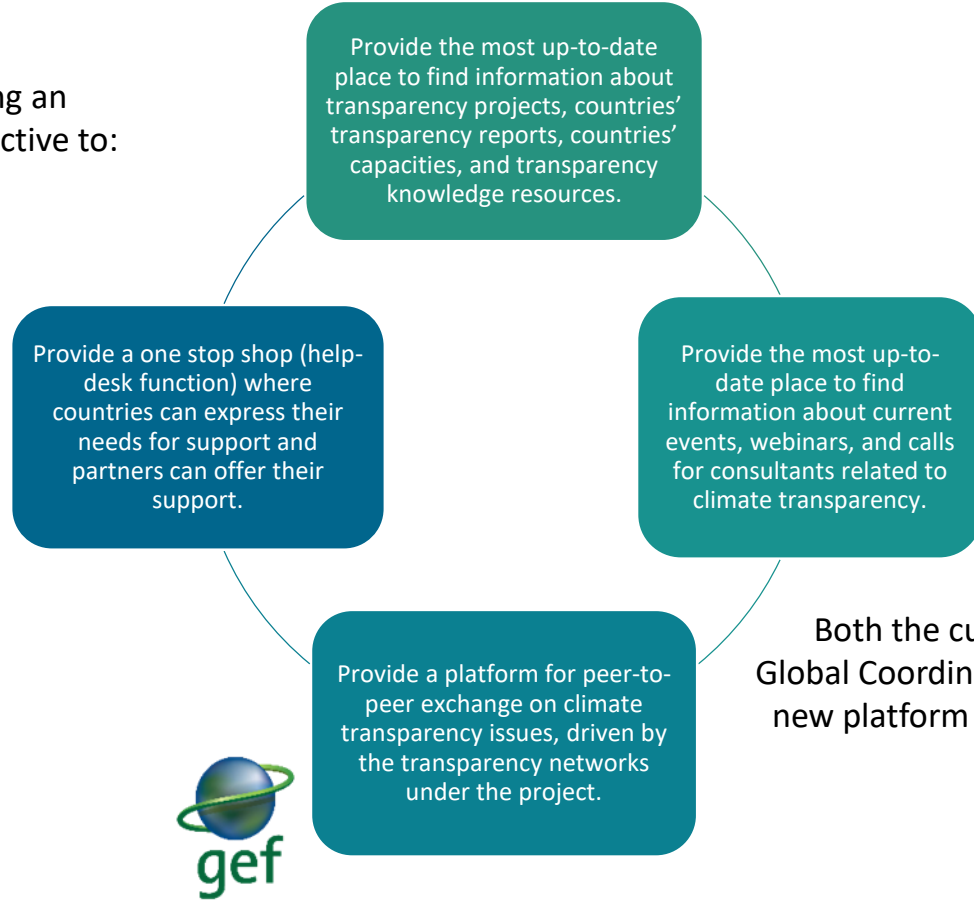

The CBIT-GSP project is developing an integrated platform with the objective to:



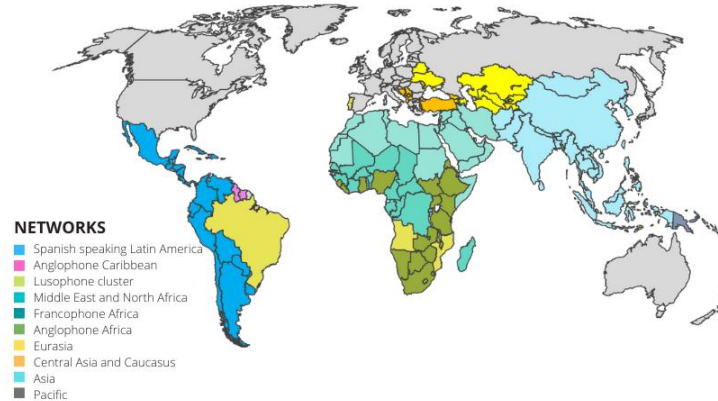

- The FAO event on Enhancing climate action in Europe and Central Asia that took place on 8 - 9 September 2022 in Istanbul, Turkey

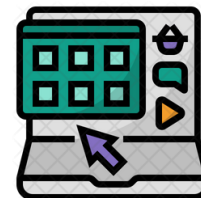
