JOINT IMPLEMENTATION

Jl encourages and rewards emission reduction initiatives **between industrialized countries** that have signed the Kyoto Protocol

Emission reduction projects in any country with a commitment under the Kyoto Protocol

Jl projects produce **emission reduction units** (ERUs)



GROWTH IN NUMBERS


INCREASE IN PROJECTS SUBMISSIONS




- **251** PDDs & **1** PoA DD published under **Track 2**
- **30** positive determinations deemed final under **Track 2**
- **40** positive verifications deemed final under **Track 2 (8.7 million tonnes CO₂e)**
- **271** Track 1 projects published

Russia has largest potential for JI

Russian participation could signal substantial increase in number of JI projects

CMP REQUESTS

PARTIES IN CANCUN DECIDED TO::

- a) initiate **first review of JI guidelines** at CMP.7 in Durban
- b) ask JISC to make **recommendations** on options for **building on JI approach**
- c) request JISC to **implement action areas from experience report**
- d) establish **provisions for charging fees on Track 1 projects** by introducing a fee

CMP REQUESTS (continued)


PARTIES IN CANCUN ENCOURAGED THE JISC TO:

- e) make further efforts to **facilitate the process of accrediting IEs**
- f) continue **enhancing implementation of verification procedure**
- g) **promote transparency and enhance interaction** between DFPs, AIEs, PPs
- h) **strengthen outreach** activities to improve overall JI understanding

CMP HAS ENDORSED JISC RECOMMENDATIONS




JI as a mitigation tool
and offset standard

- Unified JI process
- New, collaborative governing body to agree standards and oversee implementation at the national level
- Ensure transparency

- Reorient work programme
- Improve clarity of guidance
- Revise accreditation and project cycle
- Raise understanding
- Reduce delays in approval

2011–2013




- Continue processing project submissions and accreditation applications
