



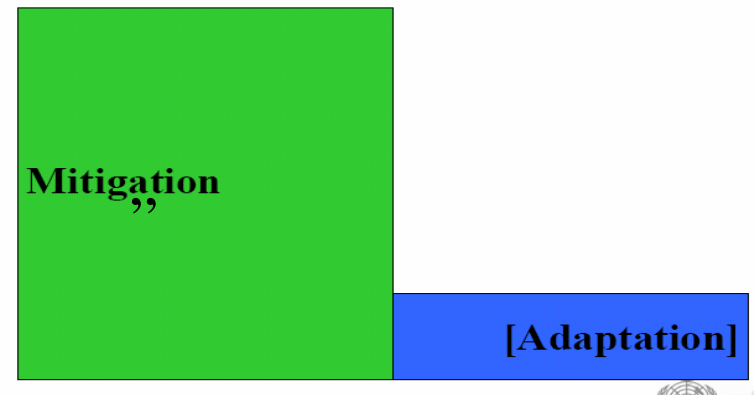

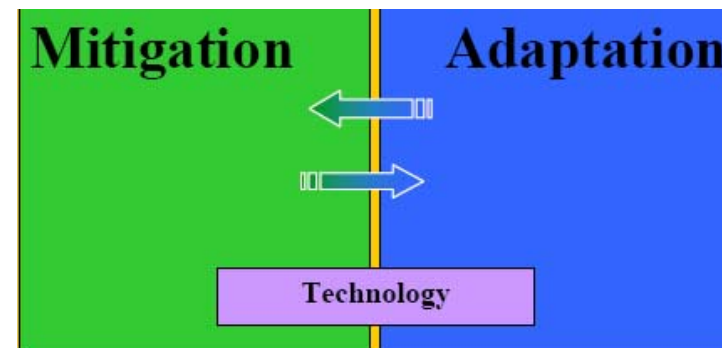
Adaptation: Managing the Unavoidable

Building Blocks 2007

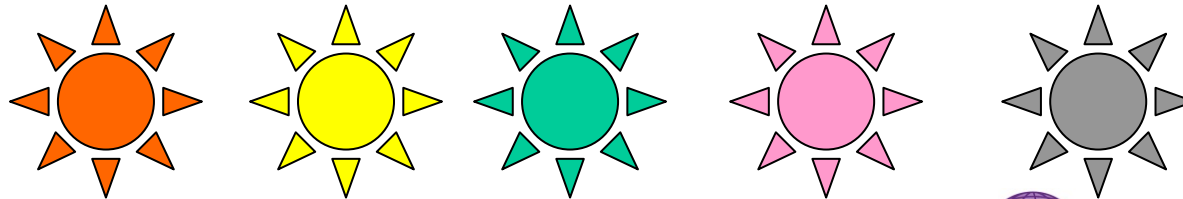
