

- Recently we take much efforts to support Thailand, Indonesia and cities in Vietnam (Ho Chi Minh, Hai Phong and Da Nang).






Thailand's Post2020 Scenarios



- Trainings, workshops and intensive discussions many times among both cities' staffs, TMG's staffs and experts have been conducted so far.






Launching of Putrajaya Green City 2025 by Datuk Haji Hashim Bin Haji Ismail, President of Putrajaya Corporation
