The Road to a Low-Carbon Future in Asia

Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES)

An initial overview of global technical abatement potential specified across regions and sectors will be presented, alongside additional estimates of abatement impact from current policies in implementation and various stages of development in the highest emitting regions and sectors. A couple of specific examples in Asia will be explored in more depth. Then, based upon key findings and lessons learnt from on the ground research and capacity building activities, this side event will discuss challenges and opportunities for Asia to pursue low-carbon development pathways. Discussion will cover topics such as low emission development strategies (LEDS), nationally appropriate mitigation actions (NAMAs), measurement, reporting and verification (MRV), short-lived climate pollutants (SLCP) and emerging research and capacity building platforms such as Low Carbon Asia Research Network (LoCARNet). A presentation outlining the human resources challenges facing the implementation of low-carbon development, drawing on an MRV case study example from the region will follow. The event will conclude with a short discussion period.
