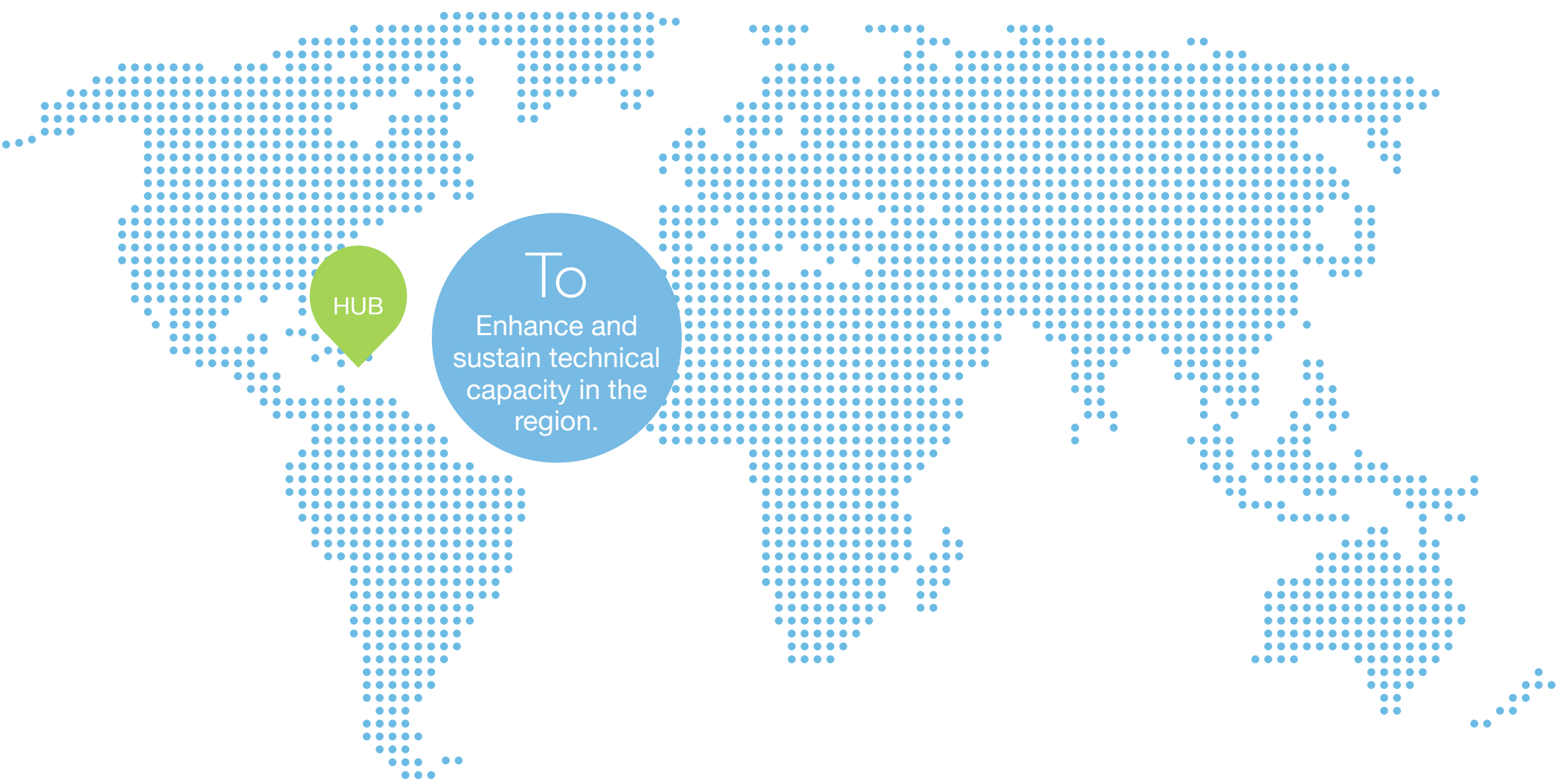
To efficiently develop GHG inventories, mitigation assessments, and track NDCs.

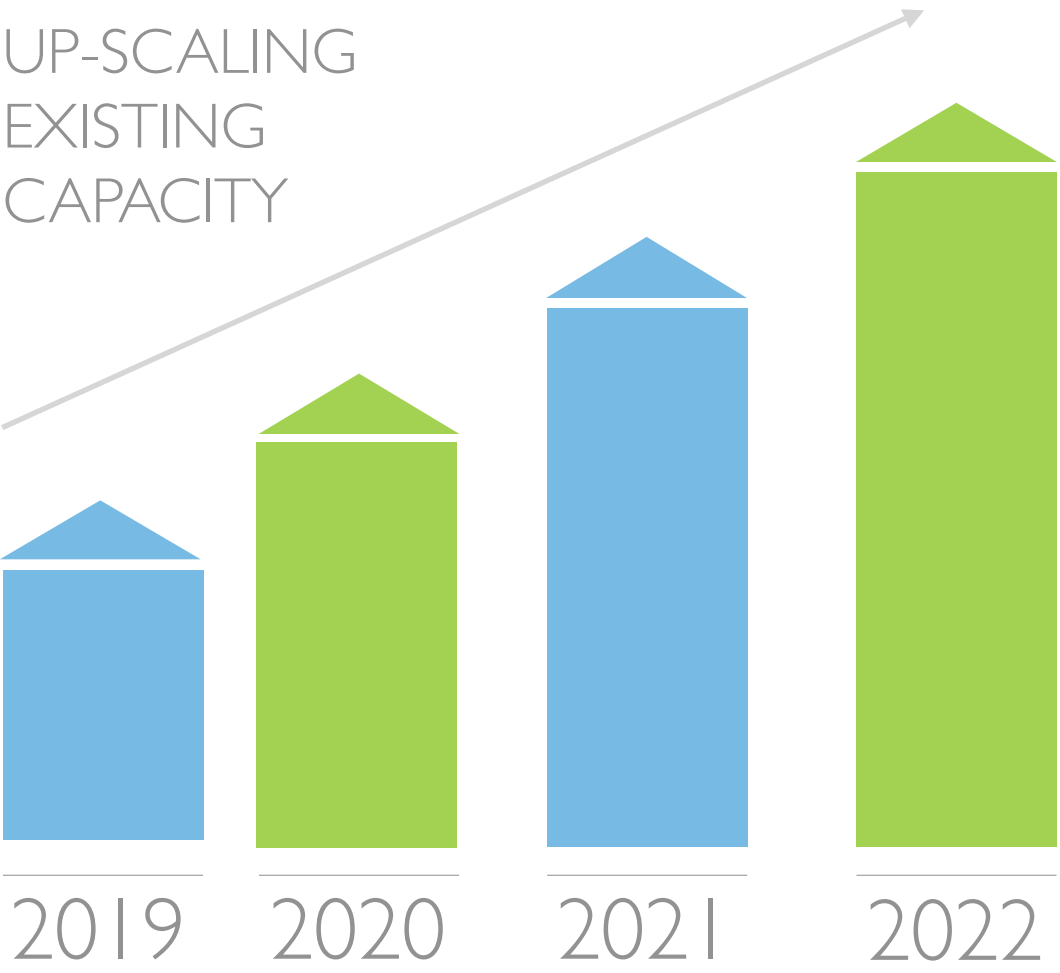
