ABSTRACT

◆Theme 1: Sectoral Approaches

(1) Japan's view on sectoral approaches for post-2012 framework

Sectoral approaches are useful in two ways:

- 1) they contribute to setting fair, ambitious and achievable national emission reduction targets for developed countries,**
- 2) they promote actions by developing countries through diffusion and transfer of the best available technologies and practices.**

Japan's view on sectoral approaches in the international framework beyond 2012 will be introduced.

(2) Report of the 2nd International Workshop on Sectoral Emission Reduction Potential

The Japanese government held the workshop on October 22nd in Paris. Co-chairs will introduce the outcomes of the workshop.

◆Theme 2: Japanese Effort and Proposals against Global Warming in Agricultural Sector

An effective methodology will be introduced to mitigate GHG emission from agricultural sector and agricultural soil management through farmers' practices including compost application for improving soil carbon sequestration.

◆Theme 3: Utilizing *Global Map* for Addressing Climate Change

The first version of the *Global Map* that contains items including Global Land Cover and Percent Tree Cover was completed in 2008 on the initiative of the Japanese government. Introduction will be made on how to utilize *Global Map* for the discussions on adaptation, LULUCF and REDD activities.

◆Theme 4: Cool Earth Partnership and Japan's ODA – JICA's Cooperation –

Initiatives under the Cool Earth Partnership and best practices of Japan's ODA addressing climate change will be presented by JICA, which has just reborn as one stop shop of development cooperation providing technical cooperation, concessional loans, and grant aid.
