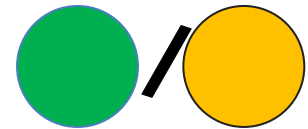
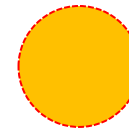
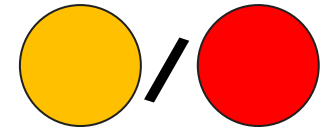
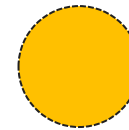
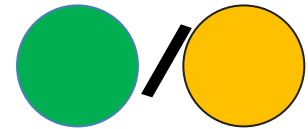
	Feasibility	Resource requirem'ts
● Assessing adaptation effort (qualitative)	 / 	 / 
● Assessing support, needs (qualitative)		 / 
● Proxy information, e.g. trends in impacts of extreme events	 / 	 / 
● Reviewing adequacy of adaptation/support		
● Reviewing effectiveness		

Reviewing overall progress to adaptation goal

Feasibility

Resource
requirem'ts

- Qualitative self-assessment (scorecard)
- Qualitative self-assessment (report to UNFCCC)
- Use of 3rd Party info (e.g. IPCC, vulnerability assessments)



Conclusions

- Feasibility of objectively meeting the 4 aims of adaptation part of global stocktake vary
 - Qualitative assessments more feasible than quantitative/comprehensive assessments
 - Assessing adequacy and effectiveness particularly challenging
- More information is needed for global stocktake than countries are asked to report individually
 - Increases information needs from third parties
 - Info from different 3rd parties can vary widely, so choice of info source potentially contentious
