

More than <u>5100</u> registered projects in <u>81</u> countries <u>1.08 billion</u> credits issued to date



CDM benefits

- USD 215 billion investment in CDM projects spurred by the end of 2012
- USD 22–43 billion foreign investment
- USD 3.6 billion compliance savings to Annex I Parties
- Helps generate and support green growth programmes globally
- 110 gigawatts of new renewable energy capacity from CDM projects
- Technology transfer
- More efficient use of capital




Number of projects entering validation per month





1. IMPROVING EFFICIENCY and CLARITY


- Finalized framework for implementation of standardized baselines
- Adopted a consolidated methodologies procedure



1. IMPROVING EFFICIENCY and CLARITY contd.


- Scaled up assessment:

 5380 R&I submission received in
 2012 (20 Nov.); commenced
 processing 4930
- Handling a rush of submissions help from a roster of experts, and shifting in-house resources



2. ENSURING ENVIRONMENTAL INTEGRITY

- Guidance strengthened: Financial benchmarking, common practice, and first of its kind
- Approved standard for quality of data used to develop standardized baselines



2. ENSURING ENVIRONMENTAL INTEGRITY contd.

- Revised industrial gas methodologies
- Revised coal methodology



3. ENHANCING REGIONAL DISTRIBUTION and SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

- PoA rules clarified and standard revised (49 PoAs registered; a fifth are in Africa)
- Rules for micro-scale projects further simplified
- Suppressed demand guidelines implemented
- Regional collaboration enhanced



3. ENHANCING REGIONAL DISTRIBUTION and SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT contd.

- Loan scheme launched
- 26 new methodologies approved
- Expanded 'positive list' of small-scale renew. energy techs. automatically deemed additional
- Approved tool project participants can use to showcase sustainable development benefits



4. IMPROVING STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

- DNA help desk
- Project participants help desk
- Provided stakeholders with a complete overview of work items to be considered by Board



4. IMPROVING STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT contd.

- TRAINING EVENTS: DNA training on PoA; 13th Global DNA Forum; 1st SDM Joint Coordination Meeting; African DNA training on POA
- Increased interaction between DOEs and the secretariat expected to help develop materiality guidelines

POLICY DIALOGUE

- Taking stock of lessons learned and recommending how to position the mechanism moving forward
- Launched in late 2011
- High-level external panel

POLICY DIALOGUE

- Three research areas: Impact,
 Governance, Future context
- Conducted stakeholder engagement meetings, issued comprehensive report in September

FUTURE OF CDM

- The future of the CDM assured with second Kyoto Protocol commitment period
- CMP has reiterated, through its regular further guidance, the importance of the CDM

FUTURE OF CDM

- CDM is a mature mechanism that has proved its worth
- Possible expanding role for the CDM in emerging emission trading systems



THE CHALLENGE

- Low demand for CERs, resulting in

- Provide clarity on ambitious emission targets
- Send clear signal about value of the CDM and how it should be used in the future climate regime
