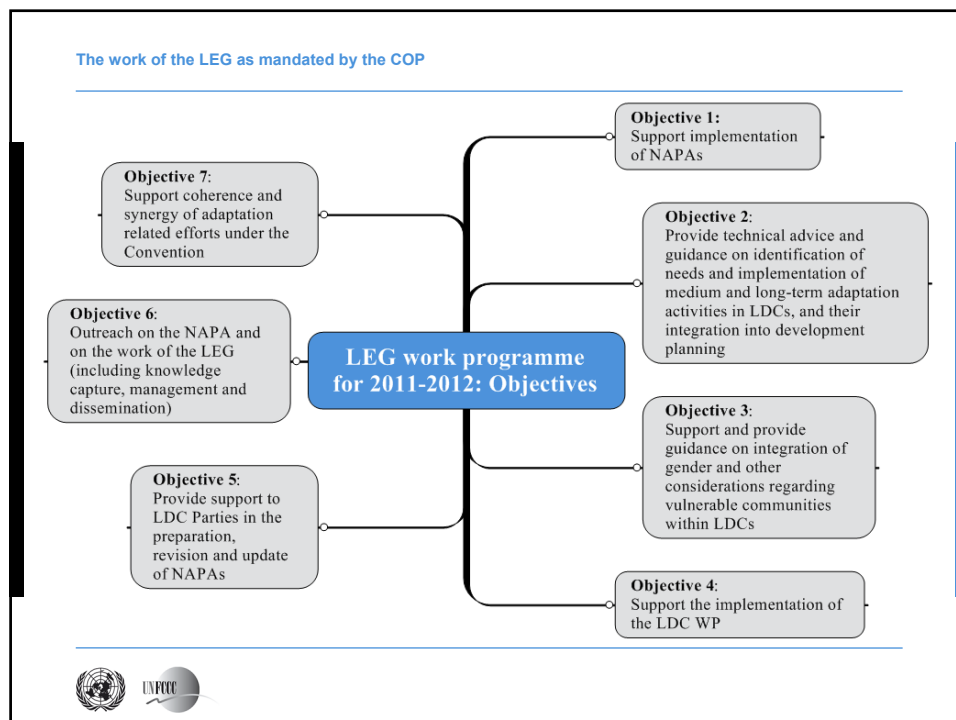

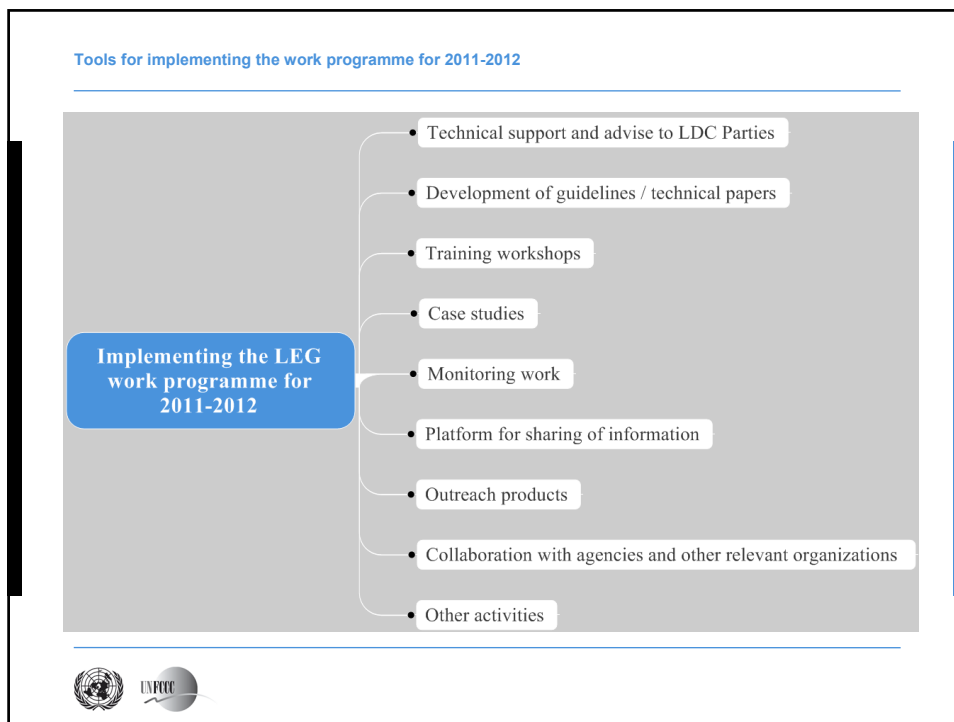

Activities carried out in 2011



The LEG held two meetings:

a) LEG 19 in Malawi:

- Continuation of work from the previous mandate of the LEG;
- Development of the work programme for 2011-2012;
- Engagement of the GEF and its agencies, and other organizations in the implementation of the LDC work programme;
- Interaction with the Malawi NAPA team.

b) LEG 20 in Lao PDR:

- Progress in implementation of the work programme in 2001;
- Priority activities for 2012;
- Interaction with the Lao PDR NAPA team.

Activities carried out in 2011

---

The LEG focused on the following specific activities in 2011:

- a) Support for, and monitoring of, preparation and implementation NAPAs;
  - b) Publication on best practices and lessons learned (EN, FR, PT);
  - c) Development of technical and information papers on:
    - Medium- and long-term adaptation in LDCs;
    - Programmatic approaches to NAPAs and other adaptation plans/strategies;
    - Gender and other considerations regarding vulnerable communities;
    - Options for accessing additional resources under the LDCF;
    - Options for implementing the LDC work programme.
  - d) Providing inputs to the work on NAPs as requested by the SBI;
  - e) Preparations for regional training workshops planned for 2012;
  - f) 10 year anniversary of the LDC work programme.

Priority activities for 2012 (1 of 2)

---

Guided by its 7 objectives, the LEG will focus on the following activities in 2012:

- Compile and analyze information on the implementation of NAPAs;
  - Conduct regional training workshops;
  - Technical paper on the role and application of technology in the implementation of NAPAs;
  - Enhance the LDC Portal, to serve as the main knowledge base on the work of the LEG, and a platform for mobilizing and engaging a wide range of organizations and institutions;
  - Design and implement a platform on best practices and lessons learned on the LDC Portal;
  - Develop updated guidelines on the preparation, revision and update of NAPAs.

Priority activities for 2012 (2 of 2)

---

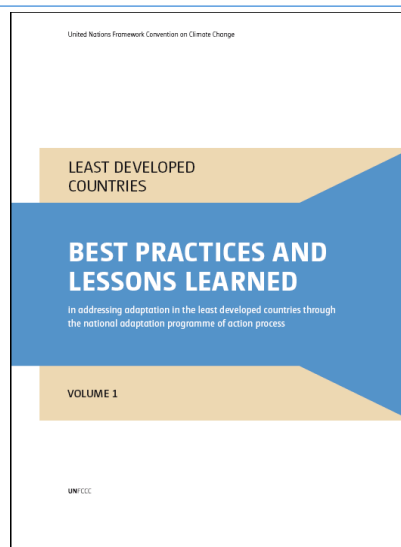
Guided by its 7 objectives, the LEG will focus on the following activities in 2012:

- Prepare papers on approaches to implementing the remaining elements of the LDC work programme;
- Initiate the development of an approach to monitoring the effectiveness of adaptation efforts in the LDCs to reduce vulnerability to climate change;
- Continue the dialogue with the LDC NAPA teams on NAPAs in order to inform the provision of further support by the LEG;
- Continue to invite the GEF and its agencies and relevant organizations and experts to the meetings and workshops of the LEG
