# Addressing the remaining elements of the LDC WP

- Building capacity for LDCs to participate effectively in intergovernmental climate change processes (\$4.5M): addresses gaps in existing support to national climate change secretariats and/or focal points, and provides training to develop the capacity of LDC negotiators
- Support for public awareness, technology transfer and climate information services is routinely provided in the context of NAPA implementation; in response to LDC demand

- Building the capacity of Rwanda's government to advance the NAP process (\$6.7M)
- Chad National Adaptation Plan (\$6.5M)

  - *ii. prepared document (circulated twice for comments) on the technical review*
  - *iii.* annexed to the GEF's report to COP 22.
- Guidance to GEF from COP 22 expected to follow up on technical review
