It presents recent research on risks for environmental integrity, including a quantitative assessment of the potential "hot air" in current NDC targets and how quantitative limits on international transfers could address the risk. Perspectives, on behalf of the PoA Working Group, discusses how up-scaled crediting mechanisms in Article 6 can learn from existing experience with programmatic approaches in the Kyoto mechanisms to support upscaled, programmatic mitigation action under Article 6 and for results-based climate finance.
