### Towards the implementation of Article 6.4 activities

#### Theme

The Supervisory Body of the Article 6.4 mechanism (SBM) and the UNFCCC secretariat have been moving ahead with the operationalisation of the Paris Agreement Crediting Mechanism (PACM). While the regulatory framework for the PACM is progressing rapidly, key stakeholders for implementing activities are still hesitating to take action. This event aims to bring together members of the SBM, government representatives, project developers and researchers to discuss Article 6.4 participation and the mobilisation of an Article 6.4 activity pipeline.
