

## Side event of the Standing Committee on Finance at COP 29

### PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

#### Objective

The SCF will facilitate an interactive session to present its key reports submitted to COP 29 and CMA 6, namely:

- The Sixth Biennial Assessment and Overview of Climate Finance Flows (**BA**);
- Second report on the determination of the needs of developing country Parties related to implementing the Convention and the Paris Agreement (**NDR**);
- Second report on progress towards achieving the goal of mobilizing jointly USD 100 billion per year to address the needs of developing countries in the context of meaningful mitigation actions and transparency on implementation (**100 billion report**);
- Report on common practices regarding climate finance definitions, reporting and accounting methods (**Common Practices Report**);
- Summary report on the SCF Forum on accelerating climate action and resilience through gender-responsive financing (**2024 Forum report**).

The event would enable participants to have an overview of the key findings of the SCF and reflect on how the outcomes will inform the climate finance agenda at COP 29. Representatives from Parties, financial institutions, governments, think-tanks UN agencies and other interested stakeholders are invited to join the side-event.

#### Format

To foster more interactive engagement between SCF members and participants, the event will follow a “gallery walk” format. At the outset, the SCF will provide an overview of the SCF’s work this year through a series of short presentations on each of the five key reports, setting the context for participants.

Each key report will have its own “gallery” in the corners of the room, where there will be 1-2 posters that capture key findings and diagrams from the report.

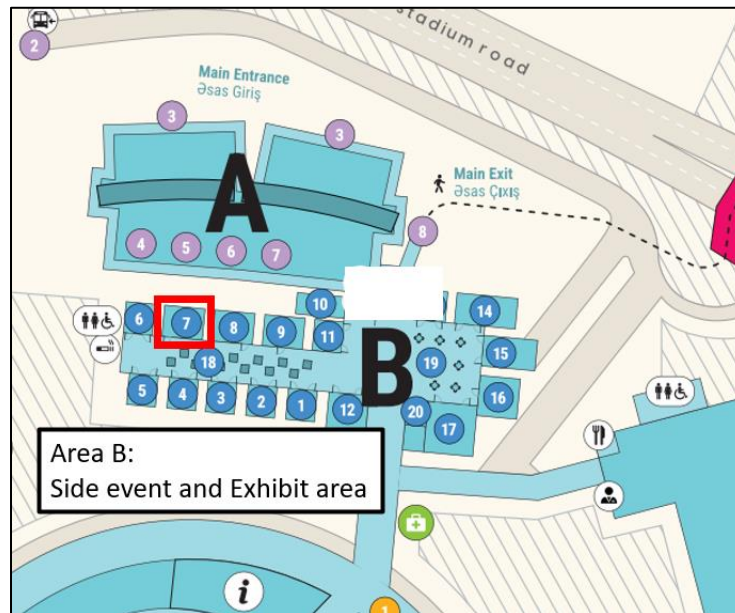
After the overview presentations, participants will be invited to visit each gallery to learn about the report and have an open conversation with the co-facilitators. Participants are free to move from one gallery to another.

After the gallery walk, participants will reconvene, and each co-facilitator will briefly summarize the conversations from their gallery. This would lead into a final Q&A session to close out the event, allowing for broader reflections and any final questions.
