# Special Report on Climate Change and Cities (SR-CITIES)

## Key Focus Areas

**Impacts:** How climate change affects urban environments, infrastructure, and populations.

**Adaptation:** Strategies for enhancing resilience and protecting urban residents and infrastructure.

**Mitigation:** Measures to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote sustainable urban development.

**Role of Cities:** Highlighting the importance of local action and governance in addressing climate change and showcasing successful examples of city-level climate initiatives.

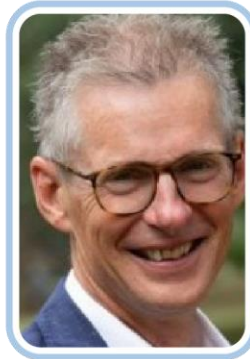

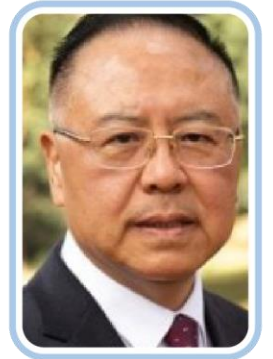

# Summary of scoping meeting and pre-scoping activities

## Nominations

- 1293 nominations were received from 92 governments, 31 observer organizations and 20 IPCC Bureau members

## Pre-scoping webinars

- 660 written responses received to pre-scoping questionnaire
- 3 webinars attended by 424 experts and 23 Bureau members, with 88 countries represented

## Scoping meeting participants

- attended by 90 experts, 13 SSC members, and 16 Bureau members, with an additional 3 experts and 4 Bureau members joining one or more sessions online
- New emphasis on urban practitioner engagement

## Outcome

- Report outline submitted to P61
- Scoping document
