Program Specifications

1. Corporate Emissions Report

- Geographical and organizational boundaries (Corporate-level data of all Mexico operations)
- Gases covered (CO₂, CH₄, N₂O, HFCs, PFC, SF₆)
- Scopes of emissions covered
 - Direct GHG emissions from sources owned or controlled by the reporting company
 - Indirect GHG emissions from purchase and consumption of electricity, heat and/or steam
 - Other indirect GHG emissions (optional)
