MALINAU REGENCY

- Located on the northern part of East Kalimantan Province, Indonesia.
- Total area 62,000 km2
- The largest regency in East Kalimantan Province



MALINAU REGENCY

- Population 56,453 people
- Multi-ethnic community dominated by Dayak (Kenyah, Merap, Londayeuh, Punan)
- Mostly are forest dependant people



FOREST IN MALINAU REGENCY

90% of the total area is forest

 Has multiple forest ecosystem types (mountainous forest – lowland tropical rainforest)

Forest dominated by high economic value Dipterocarp

FOREST IN MALINAU REGENCY

- Habitat for high conservation value of flora and fauna
- Potential for the discovery of new species of flora and fauna

To implement a pilot project to reduce carbon emission through the voluntary carbon market

THE PILOT PROJECT

- Will be implemented on three forest areas
- Total area 325,041 hectares
- This pilot project is an initial step that will provide lessons learnt on the utilization of forest ecosystem services for communities and the government of Malinau Regency



COMMUNITIES ACTIVE PARTICIPATIONS

- A forest conservation program will not success without active participation from the communities that live within and around the forest area.
- Government of Malinau Regency and GER in partnership with BTRF will implement community development program
